Course Description

Learn about the habitats, geology, plants, animals, fungi, and more of the UCSC Campus. Because this course will be taught remotely, we will also focus on developing your knowledge of the nature around wherever you are living. Using citizen science tools like iNaturalist and your own observation and inquiry skills, we will mentor you while you explore the natural world near your home. No experience is necessary, and we encourage you to apply regardless of your major or your experience spending time in nature. In addition, this small course will devote time to getting to know one another and also learn about community resources on campus, especially those related to being outside. The course is **open to any UCSC student** - you do not need to be a science major. You will receive **2-units of credit**.
